

ANNETTE INLET (PREVOST ISLAND)

CHARTS-3470, 3442 or 3313 Sheet #10

LOCATION- 48°49.94' N, 123°24.21'W

Anchor on the North-west side of the bay.

DESCRIPTION-It is a very sheltered anchorage. Strong SE winds can blow over the land at the head of the bay but seas are minimal from all directions.

NAVIGATION-The rocks off the entrance are marked by kelp in the summer months. Keep slightly to starboard when entering until past the houses on the north shore and then move out to pass close to the starboard shore at the narrow passage leading in to the inner bay. Anchor in 2-3m over a sticky/mud/shell bottom.

FACILITIES- None. Ganges with all the usual amenities is only 5nm NW.

RECOMMENDATIONS- Annette is a delightful place to anchor and just relax for a few days. Good rowing and lots of wildlife including deer, eagles, herons, etc. Note that Prevost Island is mostly a private working farm including cattle - therefore the property above the high water line is not public.
