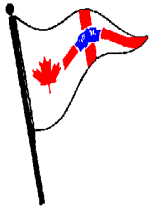

_____ Regattas: Organize and assist in running the annual regatta.

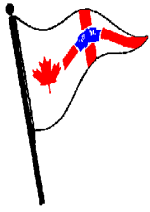
_____ CFSA Fishing Derby: Organize and run the annual fishing derby.
